Applicant Information: The Arlington Chamber of Commerce is an advocacy organization for business. Membership investments in the Chamber are not a charitable tax deduction for federal income tax purposes, but a portion is deductible as a business expense. Since the Chamber engages in lobbying, under federal law, 7% of your investment for 2015-16 is non-deductible, 93% is deductible.
